Footnotes

CANOOK was patiently ridden tracking the pace running a little off the rail, split foes mid turn, came three wide entering the stretch, edged clear mid stretch and increased advantage late under steady pressure. LIGHTNING ROAD taken in hand tracking the pace running mid track, bid in tandem mid turn racing outside the winner, vied top of the lane racing four wide, was outfinished in the final furlong but held place in a game effort. STIMULUS PLAN unhurried racing far off the pace, gained momentum coming to the quarter pole, angled out five wide for the stretch run, closed willingly picking up third place. TSUNAAMI STU stalked the leader to the half, bid mid turn and put a head in front at the quarter pole, fought hard to mid stretch, began to tire a sixteenth out. MARBLE CLIFF forwardly placed going down the backside, roused leaving the far turn, chased to top of the lane, came up empty in the drive never threatening. SMARTTHINKIN'TONY hustled leaving the gate, cleared into the first turn, set the pace traveling towards the inside, headed at the three eighths pole, fought hard to upper stretch, faded from the eighth pole.
