Footnotes

WEST LONG BRANCH went to the front and moved off the rail entering the rail entering the backside, set a nicely rated pace traveling in the three path, was asked for more leaving the quarter pole when challenged by RAID THE PARADE and THUNDER FOX, responded to draw off under energetic handling for a convincing victory. WHITE FLAME stalked the winner down the backside, angled towards the inside near the quarter pole, came again to loom mid stretch, proved no match and then dug in late saving second place. THUNDER FOX settled in the second flight, raced well off the rail throughout, advanced five wide to a menacing position at the quarter pole, was turned away mid stretch, fought willingly vying for minor awards. RAID THE PARADE rated early on, bid mid turn, almost drew even with WEST LONG BRANCH at the quarter pole, failed to sustain rally and flattened out inside the eighth pole. NEED MONEY DAD settled towards the rear, raced along the rail, asked far turn, varied little never threatening. GREY MIRAGE angled towards the inside entering the backstretch, raced up close to the half, could not keep pace from the three eighths pole, no threat. HARAMA raced towards the rear throughout, dropped off to trail past the quarter pole, dull try.
