Footnotes

RICH HERO pressed for the lead racing in a three way battle down the backside, quickly drew off to open clear advantage by mid turn, traveled in the four path entering the stretch, won easily being kept to task. SPARK PLUG settled in mid pack, rallied entering the stretch running towards the inside, chased RICH HERO in the lane, never menaced but proved a game second best. JULISKA lagged far off the pace, began to pick up momentum coming to the quarter pole, angled towards the inside mid stretch, closed strongly in deep stretch but was no threat to top pair. TONY LANTANA showed good early speed and vied briefly in three way duel down the backside, started to give way in upper stretch, used up. MORE HUMOR was moved off the rail shortly after the start, hard ridden from mid turn, failed to respond. CHIEF WATERBURY vied briefly for the lead down the backstretch, chased from mid turn, was six wide in upper stretch while giving way, finished spent. LASTRAW lacked speed, raced mid track throughout, never factored.
