BRANDYS SECRET slipped brushing the gate steadying briefly at the break, was quick to recover making the lead, dug in from the two path the final eighth holding up gamely. OH FIDDLESTIX went evenly through the turn coming four wide to upper stretch, looming abreast the leaders would bear down on the winner near the wire. PORT OF GOLD a step slow through the turn came five wide in upper stretch gaining belatedly at mid track. WHO'S THAT ONE bobbed at the break, laid close up looming through the turn into upper stretch, hard ridden in the three path proved a bit short. SHES SWISH pressed along the inside through the turn dueling from the rail in upper stretch, would waver late dropping off. BELIEVE IT HONEY away slowly trailed to upper stretch, raced six wide there. SEAHAG chased early then dropped off along the inside on the turn. NOT VERY POSH a step slow dropped back on the turn, angled out in upper stretch finding nothing .
