**Footnotes**

PENN STAR made a steady advance from mid turn, bid inside of INDIAN FOOTSTEPS entering the stretch, drew off late under firm handling. INDIAN FOOTSTEPS hustled leaving the gate, cleared and angled towards the inside, set the pace traveling two wide, collared turning for home, battled to mid stretch, ceded then dug in late saving second place in a game try. PROUD KATE raced up close from the start, came four wide top of the lane, vied for the place position but needed a bit more late besting rest. I'M FLATTERED was a step slow into stride, settled towards the rear, mildly bid in upper stretch, leveled off from mid stretch. GRILLEDHAM'NCHEESE lacked speed, raced between foes mid turn, lacked rally running six wide mid stretch, no threat. CHEERS flashed brief foot stalking to the quarter pole, started to drop off top of the stretch, no factor. PATENT PENDING quickly retreated on the bend, raced mid track offering little.
