Footnotes

HURRICANE CAMILLE vied for the lead going down the backside, shook clear at the quarter pole, put away the field by mid stretch, won in hand as much the best. WILD BLUE WONDER rated early, rallied five wide into the stretch, battled abreast rivals from mid stretch for minor awards, gained place position late in a game effort. MARSKE bobbed at the break, settled towards the rear, found best stride in upper stretch, angled seven wide with an eighth to go, finished strongly but was no threat to the winner. JUST BOOMER tracked the pace while saving ground, was hard ridden in the lane, lacked needed late kick. UMPUS AND MARGE rated early, bid five wide leaving the quarter pole, chased running between foes in the lane, was out finished late vying for minor awards. THAT'S OUR CACHE sent hard, dueled inside on the winner to mid turn, proved no match and weakened in mid stretch. RUNNAWAYTINA raced evenly in the second flight, asked but gave little response, never threatening. SHINEING ARROW was quickly outrun, never involved. BUDDHA CALL hustled and raced up close briefly, gave way entering the stretch.
