RAGIN GAGIN broke sharply to clear the field, pressed by SECRET REVENGE on the turn repelled rival to go clear again in upper stretch, held firm from the eighth pole. RUBY TEA stalked the pace through the turn angling to the six path in upper stretch, came on late to salvage place. SECRET REVENGE sent hard chased then pressed RAGIN GAGIN through the turn, repelled by the game pacesetter in upper stretch would come up short late. PEARL LUSTER slow early gave a mild rally on the turn then moved evenly through the lane holding position there. MORNINGSIDE MOON dropped off on the turn proving no menace after. PYRITE ALRIGHT showed early speed then retreated on the turn. GOOD RUNIN CARR broke slowly, raced wide playing no factor. EVERONA was never involved. PALERMO PRINCESS offered little. BUDDHA CALL labored throughout.
