DEL BONITA unhurried to the half advanced on the far turn swinging out seven wide in upper stretch surging clear in the closing yards. NOMUDONDEHERE dropping back early trailed through the far turn, taken eight wide in upper stretch responded closing in belatedly. ARROWHEAD PENELOPE well rated rallied to contention on the far turn, put a head in front at mid track in upper stretch then drifted in a bit before ceding to wide pressure. MINOR ISSUES sent clear set a pressured pace dueling through the far turn, extended on the inside of rivals down the stretch would come up a bit short. CLUNY BREEZE prompted the pace pressuring MINOR ISSUES through the far turn, extended in upper stretch would wear down between horses. SYMBOL rated back early was roused to action on the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch lacked a closing surge. DRUM ONE UP tracked the pace through the far turn then folded along the inside in upper stretch. TRINNON IN LOVE rushed out from the gate was hurried for half a mile then wilted on the far turn.
