DIXIE PIXIE nicely handled saving ground around the bend, angled out three wide launching rally entering the stretch, collared SPARKLING LOVER mid stretch, drew clear late being ridden out. SPARKLING LOVER broke alertly and vied for the lead from the start racing in the two path, held a slim advantage mid stretch, battled with the winner to the sixteenth pole, ceded stubbornly proving a game second best. GITTIN COMFY matched strides with the runner up to mid stretch traveling along the rail, began to weaken inside the furlong marker, held show in a good effort. CHASE EM rushed shortly after the start, pressed the pace racing three wide around the turn, lacked needed kick and weakened mid stretch. SASSY SHORE BREEZE raced evenly in the second flight at mid track, failed to respond despite being hard ridden. STORMY C'S trailed soon after the start, swung seven wide top of the lane, passed a couple of weary rivals but never factored. SHELBY'S A PRO lacked speed racing mid track, offered little. IDONTLIKEANYONE showed good early foot, chase to the quarter pole racing four wide, faltered in upper stretch.
