**Footnotes**

SKYANGLE was patiently ridden traveling towards the inside racing mid pack, gained momentum a=mid turn, angled to the three path entering the stretch, drove clear in upper stretch to win easily while in hand to the finish line. CUNNING ARTIST rated and trailed to the half, advanced mid turn, came six wide top of the lane, closed willingly picking up second place but never threatened the winner. SWEET JILL settled in the second flight, urged form the quarter pole, finished strongly in deep stretch gaining the show. JAZZY GIRL was hard used vying for the early lead, battled gamely to the quarter pole, had enough by upper stretch, gave way in the lane. AT HEAVENS DOOR set a pressured pace racing along the rail, fought hard to the quarter pole, weakened from upper stretch. STARSHIP SAPPHIRE pressed the pace to the half running three wide, began to chase around the bend, remained a threat to the quarter pole then faded from mid stretch. INDY'S CHARGE raced up close to the pace running along the rail, tried to come thru a narrow opening at the quarter pole, lacked sufficient room and rider had to check losing momentum, angled out in upper stretch but failed to threaten. CITY RANSOM was forwardly placed for the run down the backside, failed to respond leaving the far turn, weakened near the quarter pole. UNVEIL THE TRUTH raced in mid pack to the half, steadily retreated from mid turn, no factor. CHANGEYOURATTITUDE was always outrun, showed little.
