AWEEONEINTHEBUNKER rushed into the far turn, dueled racing three wide around the bend, edged clear entering the stretch, increased margin under steady handling to the wire. SUPERTUNIA was never far off the pace racing four to three wide around the turn, made a bold move near the quarter pole, got up late gaining second place in a hard effort. SIERRA THUNDER sent hard and dueled with the winner to upper stretch, yielded stubbornly and was out noddled missing second place in last jumps, game try. MOLINARO MISSION tracked early on running four wide, put to a drive leaving the quarter pole, lacked needed surge besting rest. JO JO JUICE raced up close running towards the inside to the quarter pole, angled out turning for home under a drive, lacked bid and weakened in the lane. BELLARIFFIC lacked speed racing towards the rear, swung out seven wide top of the lane, failed to factor. WHOWHATWHY was hustled early and tracked to mid turn, began to fade past the quarter pole finishing well beaten. BANK ON INEZ was quickly outrun racing wide, eased entering the stretch, did complete the course.
