Footnotes

BEST IN EGBERT was squeezed shortly after the start causing the rider to take up and briefly lost his left iron, settled in the second fight, gained turning for home, split foes in upper stretch, surged strongly nearing the wire to arrive in time for a very game victory. BODACIOUS GIFT pressed for the early lead traveling two to three wide, cleared moving off leaving the quarter pole, angled to the rail in upper stretch, was put to strong encouragement in deep stretch but was run down just missing in a solid effort. CHICKASAW KID tracked the duelers down the backside, closed in inside the eighth pole, vied in a three way battle coming to the wire racing between, was outgamed in last strides to settle for third place. FATHERFORGIVEME brushed BEST IN EGBERT leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, was abruptly angled six wide at the eighth pole, surged strongly in deep stretch to narrowly miss a minor award. NUMEROUS ONE tracked around the turn racing wide, bid in upper stretch, gave chase to the wire needing a bit more late. OH SO LO came out leaving the gate crowding rivals briefly, raced mid pack saving ground, failed to respond when roused never menacing. WET 'N WILD CAT raced up close to the pace soon after the start, loomed off the runner up at the quarter pole, began to tire with a furlong to go, no late factor. MANDATE LANE lacked speed running towards the rear, varied little never factoring. MR TALC was quickly outrun, showed little. DANGEROUS WARRIOR was hard used in the early going vying for the lead, dropped off top of the stretch finishing spent.
