Footnotes

DANCER SPIRIT broke sharply taking control, set all the pace racing along the inside, was never seriously threatened and increased margin under steady handling to the wire for a convincing victory. JETINA trailed to the quarter pole while saving ground, split foes in upper stretch, angled out three to four wide inside the eighth pole, made a furious late bid to grab second place on the wire. FINAL DECREE settled in the second flight, rallied between foes mid stretch, chased the winner to the wire, was nosed out of second place in last jump. TOO HOT BABY showed good early foot stalking the winner along the rail, could not keep pace from upper stretch, tired late being outfinished for a minor award. SPERANZA well placed racing along the rail in mid pack, failed to respond when asked, bested rest. SIX PACKEN PATTIE reared as the gate opened leaving herself a huge task to overcome, raced wide throughout, improved placing but failed to factor. FLASHY PANTS was hustled leaving the gate but lacked early speed, moved off the rail around the bend, swung five wide under a drive top of the lane, failed to respond. SALO'S DREAM raced evenly in mid pack, traveled between foes around the bend, lacked rally and was vanned off after the finish. VINELAND ROAD stalked to the quarter pole running three wide, began to fade in upper stretch, used up. LIVEWIRE LOUISE raced in the second flight briefly, retreated from the quarter pole, stopped in upper stretch finishing well beaten.
