**Footnotes**

ICAR settled early advanced through the turn drawing even abreast DURAND PARK in upper stretch, crowded and brushed by rival near the eighth pole continued to battle brushing in close quarters late while prevailing gamely. DURAND PARK rushed up along the rail to grab the lead on the turn, hooked in the three path upper stretch angled out brushing with ICAR near the eighth pole continuing on in close quarters battling to the end. DUKE OF ASPEN slow early cut the corner to upper stretch bidding willingly late along the rail. TO THE LEFT away slowly circled out on the turn gaining to threaten in the six path upper stretch, widest of the contenders would hang late. POLITICAL CHIEF hopped then lost footing at the break, went evenly through the turn angling to the four path in upper stretch gaining a bit late. K'S BOYWONDER pressured the pace four deep through the turn extending into upper stretch weakening late in the three path. MONEY MAKES broke alertly pressing early on the inside, wavered on the turn fading in the two path upper stretch. GHOST HILL pressured the pace through the turn then faded at mid track in upper stretch. SHY LOVER broke sharply moving the pace through the turn, gave way while drifting to the six path in upper stretch. CASANOVA GIANT flashed early speed then folded up on the turn. An objection from the rider of DURAND PARK against the rider of ICAR for interference during the stretch run was disallowed by the stewards.
