Footnotes

GIN KINGS pressed for the lead from the start, moved clear along the rail at the quarter pole, received strong left handed stick from mid stretch, widened to the finish winning convincingly. BILLY GOES TO JAIL settled mid pack, rallied four wide under a drive turning for home, finished willingly proving second best but failed to threaten the winner. SENOR UNO brushed leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, rallied four to five wide upper stretch, gained belatedly picking up a minor award. HARD TWO IMAGINE trailed racing at mid track, swung six wide into the stretch, found best stride too late. CATCHUPDOUBLEUP broke well and set a pressured early lead, headed by the winner on the bend, relinquished the lead mid turn, chased to upper stretch, faded in the final furlong. TURF KING lacked speed running towards the inside throughout, mildly improved position but failed to factor. HUNTER'S ICE settled in mid pack saving ground, varied little never menacing. CHO pressed the pace to mid turn, dropped off top of the stretch traveling three wide, used up. BARBARA'S CHOICE was always outrun, offering little. COUGAR'S SHADOW flashed brief foot running along the rail, gave way past the quarter pole.
