ROYAL CRYPT was brushed leaving the gate, rushed up to press WACKY WAYNE for the lead mid turn, drive clear near the quarter pole, was soon headed by PEEKABOO VISION from his outside top of the lane, lost the lead briefly to that rival in mid stretch, came again nearing the wire inching up to gain the victory in a very determined effort. PEEKABOO VISION broke a bit out brushing ROYAL CRYPT at the start, stalked to the quarter pole, quickly moved for the lead entering the stretch, put a head in front at the furlong marker, matched strides to the wire but was outgamed in last jumps missing in a good effort. BALOO BEAR lacked speed trailing to mid turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch, finished willingly picking up third place but never menaced top pair. WACKY WAYNE broke alertly and angled inside with the lead going into the far turn, headed at the quarter pole, battled to upper stretch, weakened inside the eighth pole and was edged for third place late. CHIQUITO KISSES hustled to race up close to mid turn, gave chase turning for home, lacked response never threatening. CHUCKY CAN FLY raced inside to mid turn, angled out under a drive at the quarter pole, failed to respond, no factor. HEZA BELFAST was always outrun racing wide throughout.
