DAKOTA FREEWAY slow early fired to upper stretch, angled three wide driving up in the closing yards. BLACKFEET outrun early came five wide to upper stretch, rallied late at mid track. RAPID DEVELOPMENT broke sharply, pressed a short lead to upper stretch, dug in ceding to outside pressure late. EFFERVESCENT CHARM tracked evenly through the turn, loomed four wide down the stretch, hung. SCOOBY off slowly saved ground to upper stretch, gained belatedly. GATO ESPACIAL hustled out pressed into upper stretch then wore down late. CANT SPELL chased the pace through the turn then weakened at mid track. NEWBURY was never involved finishing five wide. NO RISK NO GAIN was always outrun. THE BIG STORY had brief foot then gave way on the turn.
