Footnotes

BUCK CASH patiently ridden to the quarter pole, launched rally coming four wide upper stretch, finished strongly to blow by a pair of duelers in deep stretch, won going away. WIGAMOG stalked early on traveling three wide, drew even mid stretch, vied to deep stretch, was no match for the winner in last jumps but managed to gain second place in a hard effort. MAGESTIC HEART sent hard in the opening strides, cleared going into the far turn, held a slim advantage around the bend, headed at the eighth pole, dug in under pressure but yielded late to settle for third place. LIFT OFF stalked the pace from the start, held a menacing position mid stretch, began to tire inside the eighth pole, no late threat. BLUES CROSSING settled in the second flight, saved ground throughout, showed belated action improving placing but never menaced. HOT CHILI settled in the second flight, raced mid track throughout, angled six wide mid stretch, bested rest. TETON STAR tracked around the turn racing four to five wide, lacked response when roused and tired in the drive. MARSHMELLOW MAN raced wide being outrun, showed little. FLASH JORDAN lacked speed, gave way at the quarter pole dropping far off the pace, dull try. MATTY'S SONG flashed brief speed racing along the inside, stopped upper stretch, pulled up deep stretch, rider dismounted, bled.
