MY POWER BULLET well handled sitting patient stalking a pair of duelers to the far turn, quickly moved three wide mid turn, took over at the quarter pole, opened up from upper stretch, won easily being kept to task. MEGHA rated early racing mid track, came three to four wide entering the stretch chasing the winner, failed to threaten but finished a willing second. LEXIACOMO lagged far off the early pace saving ground, hard ridden from the three eighths gaining momentum, swung out four wide mid stretch, finished with interest picking up third place. PINK TIE GIDGET rated and traveled in the second flight, swung five wide upper stretch, showed belated action improving placing. WITHOUT A DREAM tracked the pace running four wide to the half, bid mid turn and loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, could not keep pace in upper stretch and angled to the rail, flattened out in the drive. STRATEGIC ZENNA dueled from the start, gained a slight edge at the half, headed by the winner mid turn, was no match entering the stretch, gave way mid stretch, used up. QUIKDRAW BELLSTAR was hard used vying for the early lead, battled to the half, faded from mid turn and was all done in upper stretch, spent. INSIDE THE PEARL was always outrun, never involved.
