DONT BLAME THE CAT hustled out worked on a short lead through the turn, dug in form the three path down the lane, held up driving. AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT went evenly at mid pack, rallied from mid track down the stretch, bid gamely late. TIN SOLDIER slow early came six wide upper stretch, closed in late. CLAPHAM chased and pressed three wide through the turn, extended down the lane hung late. GOLDEN LINKS slow early saved ground to upper stretch, gained a bit at the rail. LOOKOFANEAGLE away alertly pressed between horses on the turn, weakened to upper stretch. KYLE'S TREASURY slow early played no factor. ACADEMY KING was always outrun. SOUPER VEX dropped back early.
