Footnotes

PICKI hustled and was involved in a three way early duel, raced along the inside on the turn, shook clear near the 1/4 pole, came off the rail entering the stretch, widened throughout the lane in a sharp effort. MACKINAW ISLAND was rated early, raced towards the inside throughout, asked mid turn, split foes near the 1/4 pole, rallied along the rail for the drive, proved second best. JUST PLAIN LUCKY was slow early, raced inside on the turn, had no room mid turn, had to wait near the 1/4 pole, angled out 5 wide top of the lane, was under strong left handed stick and closed well from mid stretch to the wire. I THINK I CAN bumped with HATCHETSFLYINGIRL leaving the gate, rushed to vie for the early lead, dueled while between rivals on the turn, chased into the lane, tired from mid stretch. LADY ABBY sent hard, vied early for the lead while 3 wide, fell back slightly near the 1/4 pole, chased into the lane under a drive, weakened mid stretch. HATCHETSFLYINGIRL bumped start, evenly, mid pack, angled upper stretch, lacked rally. BEXLEY well placed while 4 wide, tracked speed duel on the turn, asked for more near the 1/4 pole, weakened in upper stretch. ALL THAT SASS well placed early along the rail, chased from mid turn under a drive, lacked rally and weakened near the 1/4 pole. NEVER UNDER lacked speed, raced wide, no factor.
