Footnotes

TRICKY IMAGE sent hard, dueled inside of WHAT'S YOUR HURRY to mid turn, put that rival away leaving the quarter pole, drew off convincingly being ridden out to the finish. TIMMY STAR well placed throughout, saved ground on the turn, was hard ridden chasing the winner entering the stretch, never menaced but gamely proved second best. LUCKY EXPRESS tracked a contested pace from the start, roused at the quarter pole, lacked needed kick, bested rest. DEPUTY DIRECTOR unhurried and raced in the second flight, angled to split foes upper stretch, bid belatedly but was no real threat. R SMOKEN STAR raced evenly under a rating, angled five wide under a drive top of the stretch, failed to respond. MISTER TORNADO was bumped by WHAT'S YOUR HURRY at the break, trailed to the quarter pole, did find best stride too late, improved placing but was no factor. VICTORY MOONDANCE angled to the rail going down the backside, raced inside throughout, hard ridden from mid turn, never factored. WHAT'S YOUR HURRY broke out and bumped MISTER TORNADO leaving the gate, quickly sent up to duel with TRICKY IMAGE, battled to the quarter pole, began to give way top of the stretch, was all done by the eighth pole. CYNTHIANA'S SONG lacked speed, raced mid track, weakened leaving the quarter pole, no factor. CITY CODE hustled to race briefly in mid pack, gave way entering the stretch, finished well beaten.
