Footnotes

PRINCE OF SALT LAKE unhurried and trailed to mid turn, quickly gained leaving the quarter pole, bid four wide mid stretch, drew even a sixteenth out, surged clear to win going away. ROYAL GOLIATH stalked early, bid top of the lane, vied between foes at the sixteenth pole, was out gamed late, hard try. CHIEF'S SWORD came away alertly, set a pressured pace, dug in from top of the lane, ceded grudgingly in deep stretch. ROCKER CHAD raced up close throughout, loomed along the rail during the stretch run, was in close quarters at the finish, game effort. TEHACHAPI rated early, asked turning for home, received severe left handed stick, showed interest at the finish. ICE PARK tracked the pace under a rating, came five wide upper stretch, lacked late kick. DYNOMIGHTRUNAWAY pressed for the lead running four wide, began to chase from the quarter pole, faded mid stretch. LAUGHING BRAVE outrun, never involved. MR. WINCHESTER lacked speed, quickly faded on the turn, dull effort.
