Footnotes

TONY LANTANA stalked through the turn rallying to draw even alongside CHIEF'S SWORD in upper stretch, angled in under right hand urging while edging off late. WAR SONG raced evenly early advancing to contention on the turn, loomed at mid track in upper stretch coming on late to secure place. CHIEF'S SWORD sent clear from the gate hustled an honest pace through the turn, collared in upper stretch first angled out then lugged in late impeding POLITE LIL SIR in the process. ALEDO SPLASH raced mid pack edging a bit closer to upper stretch, asked there had no late surge. POLITE LIL SIR slow early would vary little into upper stretch, hit stride a sixteenth out surging late only to be shut off by CHIEF'S SWORD as rider was forced to check yards from the wire. BOBBIE'S DEVIL failed to respond. U BETCHA JOE failed to compete. CHIEF WINDSONG was always outrun. A STEWARDS INQUIRY DETERMINED THAT CHIEF'S SWORD LUGGED IN LATE IMPEDING POLITE LIL SIR IN THE PROCESS. CHIEF SWORD WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FIFTH.
