CHAMP DE MARS pressed down the backed, edged clear near the quarter pole, drove clear in upper stretch, won comfortably under steady handling. MARLI'S MAN well placed racing along the inside to the quarter pole, angled out four wide top of the stretch, closed willingly. MYSTERY HUNTER was sent hard form the gate, battled with the winner holding a slight lead down the backside, fought hard to top of the lane, weakened with a furlong to go, game effort. BIG ROCKIN' DADDY settled in the second flight, came six wide into the lane, gave belated action. TRI SEVENTYFIVE well placed stalking early on, hard ridden splitting foes in upper stretch, lacked needed surge. PERI PERI raced along the rail in mid pack, mildly gained from the quarter pole, flattened out in the drive. GOLDEN LINKS was sluggish being outrun to the quarter pole, showed some late interest improving placing but never factored. CLAYBIRD was a step slow into stride, failed to factor. SECRET DESIGN raced wide down the backside being outrun, never involved. BACKTOSQUAREONE hustled giving chase to the quarter pole traveling three to four wide, began to fade entering the stretch, used up.
