RAIN SONG broke sharply, set the pace in hand from the four path, was asked for more nearing the eighth pole, lasted under strong handling. COUNTRY DIVA well placed, stalked under a rating, angled four to five wide in upper stretch, was slowly getting to the winner at the wire, game effort. QUELLE SURPRISE hustled from the gate, stalked RAIN SONG while saving ground, kept to steady pressure from the quarter pole, began to tire in deep stretch, good try. THERMAL HAZE lacked speed, moved over to the rail shortly after the start, roused at the quarter pole, angled wide into the stretch, closed ground late in willing manner. TIME FOR ETBAUER raced mid pack and towards the rail on the turn, hard ridden but failed to menace. SHE'S THAT CAT hustled along, raced mid track throughout, lacked late kick. LANTERN COURT was quickly outrun, raced wide throughout, was never involved. SOUTHERN WAY showed little, gave way mid stretch.
