Footnotes

TOUCH TRADITION unhurried early gave a mild rally on the far turn taking aim in the four path upper stretch, surged at a tiring leader late getting a nose down on the wire. GOLANI RULES broke alertly setting a modest pace drawing out through the far turn into upper stretch, digging in from the two path became weary late missing in the final jump. BELL BLITZ tracked the pace moving evenly through the backside, dropped off on the far turn regrouping in the six path upper stretch, gave steady response closing the gap late. GRAN TIRO stalked the pace saving ground to upper stretch, extending along the rail gave all. EL PATRONE slow early stayed back through the far turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch gained belatedly. SEE THAT DEVIL prompted the pace chasing through the far turn, would weaken in the three path mid stretch. TIME TIX AHEAD stalked the pace through the far turn then gave way at mid track in upper stretch. WOODMAN'S SOUL was never involved. SARAVA RULES played no factor. SIR COSTALOT folded up after a half mile.
