**Footnotes**

LADY FLICKER set a well rated pace running along the rail, headed by SWEDISH BEAUTY at the quarter pole, had more putting that rival away mid stretch, won comfortably being kept to task. MINON rated early running in the second flight, gained mid turn splitting foes, angled three wide mid stretch chasing the winner, finished a willing second best. MAMBO SKY well placed going down the backside, advanced along the rail form mid turn, secured third place in willing manner. SWEDISH BEAUTY stalked the winner from the start, almost drew even at the quarter pole, was turned away by mid stretch and weakened being outfinished for a minor award. QUEEN OF FORTUNE stalked early on traveling three to four wide, loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and flattened out inside the furlong marker. ONE NICE ROANOKE trailed to the half, gained form mid turn, came five wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to threaten while besting rest. SPECIAL VICTORY lacked speed racing towards the rear, slightly improved placing but never factored. DEPUTY'S CITIZEN raced in mid pack to the half, faded from mid turn, offered little. I'LL FIND YOU was a step slow leaving the gate, never involved. RUNNING EAGLE raced along the rail in mid pack to the half, gave way upper stretch and finished being eased across the wire.
