CANADIAN HOME RUN stalked the pace angling abreast dueling rivals in upper stretch, hooking BELIEVE DAT was bumped and carried out a bit near the sixteenth pole before edging up late. BELIEVE DAT hustled out would pressure abreast RONALDO through the turn, engaged by CANADIAN HOME RUN would come out under left hand urging bumping rival near the sixteenth pole ceding grudgingly in the last yards. RONALDO broke alertly pressing to keep a head in front through the turn, extended in the two path upper stretch would gradually wear down. MARATHON MOON lunged missing the break, outrun through the turn angled to the three path in upper stretch gaining a bit while no menace. BATON ROUGE slow early came four wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. TAXICAB swung out early raced a step slow throughout finishing at mid track. BACKTRACKEN was always outrun. CALL ME JUNIOR folded up on the turn.
