MORE THAN A REASON well handled, sat patient to the quarter pole racing along the inside, moved out to split foes entering the stretch, bid between in upper stretch, angled to the rail near the eighth pole, edged clear under strong handling in deep stretch. LIGHTNING ROAD was brushed by REALITTOUR at the break, was quickly rushed racing five wide into the far turn, pressed and vies for the lead from mid turn, put a head in front mid stretch, could not hold off MORE THAN A REASON in deep stretch, held place in a very hard effort. BERRY'S PRIDE sent hard, set a pressured pace racing between rivals throughout, battled gamely to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly in a solid effort. NATIVE TONGUE raced up close in the early stages, was briefly in take steadying briefly mid turn, angled six wide in upper stretch, finished in willing manner. ZEKE raced up close soon after the start, was briefly in tight mid turn, angled five wide to a menacing position in upper stretch, was hard ridden but lacked needed late kick. MR. FLAMBOYANT was rushed from the gate, vied along the rail to top of the stretch, began to weaken at the eighth pole, used up. REALITTOUR broke out to brush LIGHTNING ROAD, dropped off going into the far turn, angled to the rail, saved ground around the turn, never factored.
