GLORY BLAZE stalked the pace edging to PATENT PENDING looming boldly from mid track in upper stretch, made no headway on the winner needing all late to salvage place. WYNN FOR MARY a step slow in second flight saved ground finding stride to upper stretch coming on there to finish well. NICE DAY tracked through the turn coming six wide to upper stretch, hard urged there lacked late response. I'M DUE THE GOLD was always a step slow failing to contend. FOUR P'S shied in at the break then rushed to the early lead, pressed inside of PATENT PENDING to upper stretch gradually wearing down along the inside late. KENTUCKY KITTY failed to compete. MELT DOWN hopped slightly missing the break, struggled after. CLASSIFIED FLIGHT gave way on the turn.
