COUNTRY HUMOR well placed sat patient stalking to the far turn, responded there surging past WEST LONG BRANCH to grab the lead in upper stretch widening late then holding BILLYBECK at bay late. BILLYBECK unhurried early advanced on the far turn, circled eight wide in upper stretch took aim at COUNTRY HUMOR pressing that one hard in the final yards. WEST LONG BRANCH stalked the pace rallying to draw even on the far turn, ceded to COUNTRY HUMOR in upper stretch, extended late came up short. YOUR HOUR'S UP slow early gave a mild move on the far turn, gave even action at mid track down the lane needing more. CANDID IMAGE was bumped hard losing balance at the break, played no factor after. BUDDHA CALLING veered out at the break, stalked through the far turn then weakened in upper stretch. OURTIMETODANCE crowded at the break would labor. STASH THE BOOTS failed to respond. LOOK OUT MAN set the pace through the backside, passed on the far turn had nothing left in upper stretch.
