Footnotes

NEWPORT LULU stalked from the start, bid two wide top of the lane, drove clear under strong left handed stick mid stretch, held a firm advantage under steady pressure. SASSY AND SHEIKH quickly showed in front and angled to the rail, headed by the winner upper stretch, battled to the eighth pole, ceded grudgingly and dug in late saving second place. PATENT PENDING well placed from the start, angled to the three path upper stretch mounting bid, needed more late despite being hard ridden. FULLY EXPOSED tracked while traveling mid track, raced five wide under a stiff drive upper stretch, failed to menace. SPANISH SALSA reared at the break, moved off the rail soon after the start, came five wide upper stretch making her move, leveled off mid stretch besting rest. MAGGIE'S JEWEL raced evenly in the second flight, slightly improved placing in the lane running along the rail bit failed to factor. DUETTINA flashed brief early foot, chased to top of the lane, weakened in the drive. CLUNY BREEZE outrun, offered little. MADAME ALI lacked speed racing wide around the turn. ALPHA TAMMY hustled leaving the gate, raced four to five wide around the bend, steadily faded from the quarter pole, dull effort.
