Footnotes

THIN ICE sent clear set the pace off the inside through the turn, dropped to the inside in upper stretch widening late in the two path. FOMO broke sharply stalking THIN ICE close up through the turn, extending abreast rival in the three path down the stretch proved no match. VINDICTIVE chased the pace through the turn angling to mid track in upper stretch finishing evenly. GRANDE BOLD slow early angled inside upper stretch going evenly late along the rail. BERYL'S WAY outrun through the turn came five wide upper stretch holding position late. DAILY CATCH slow early played no factor. PAEONIA SUFFRUTICO was always a step slow. AUTIE faded on the turn. SEEKING RICHES breaking slowly would labor throughout. DUE CONSIDERATION was always outrun before tiring.
