Footnotes

SHADOW HALL rushed from the gate, dueled briefly with COSSIO, left the field behind turning for home, won in hand as much the best. CELESTIAL MOON was bumped by THE RIGHTFUL HEIR leaving the gate, settled in mid pack, angled five wide into the lane, chased the winner while never threatening but willingly gained second place late. LATE DOUBLE JACK raced evenly while off the rail in mid pack, swung out six wide into the stretch, surged late securing third place in good try. COCOMO JAVA broke alertly but was quickly out sprinted for the lead, chased the winner around the turn, angled out into the lane, came up empty in the drive. SPECIALNESS trailed to mid turn, swung out seven wide upper stretch, mildly improved position but never factored. PHOEBUS RISING lacked speed and raced along the inside throughout, offered little never factoring. THE RIGHTFUL HEIR broke outward bumping CELESTIAL MOON, settled in the second flight, offered little when roused, no threat. COSSIO sent hard from the gate dueling briefly with the winner, gave way entering the stretch, stopped mid stretch and was eased across the finish line.
