Footnotes

SARGE'S slow early stayed back through the turn, emerged in the six path upper stretch finding best stride a sixteenth out surging clear at the end. MOBY DIP stalked the pace edging closer on the turn, dueled in upper stretch wresting the lead in the three path only to be overpowered from the outside lane. SHORE TEE outrun through the turn swung seven then eight wide down the lane improving past tired ones late. GRUBBY'S GIFT chased the pace through the turn saving ground to upper stretch, vying along the rail weakened late. LIFEGUARD sent hard was rushed on lead through the turn, hooked in upper stretch would wilt along the inside. JOE'S LAD hustled up early threatened on the turn, all out near mid track in upper stretch would tire late. TINTO played no factor. STORM BY was always outrun. AL FAASIL broke rank thrashing his head about being steadied early. SEA DOCTOR raced second flight tiring to upper stretch.
