Footnotes

LE BEE was patiently handled in the early going, made a quick three wide bid mid turn, drove clear past the quarter pole, widened on the field while drifting out nearing the wire. RUN WITH RACHEL settled towards the rear racing mid track, rallied splitting foes turning for home, gave chase throughout the stretch run, never menaced and dug in late saving second place. LEGALLY SPEAKING lagged far off the early pace, rallied from the quarter pole, bid between rivals in upper stretch, angled to the three path inside the eighth pole, surged late missing second place. TOUR FOR LOVE raced evenly in mid pack, raced in the five path under a drive top of the stretch, lacked response. TRACY'S STAR was off a step slow, quickly angled over to the rail, rushed going in to the first turn, edged clear entering the backside, set the pace to midway on the second turn, had little left giving way entering the stretch, used up. ASHEE stalked the leader from the start, vied briefly in a three way battle mid turn, began to give way top of the lane, spent. PURE MARY stalked to the half racing off the rail, gave way past the quarter pole, stopped and was eased in mid stretch, .
