VERSAILLES SONG pressured the pace along the inside through the turn, cut the corner shaking clear in upper stretch, shown the whip was hand ridden to wire. DITCH THE ACT a step slow early came under a vigorous ride on the turn, responded five wide in upper stretch rallying a clear second best at mid track. BATTLE OF T GIANTS ducked in after leaving the gate, rallied from the turn coming in close quarters between horses at the head of the stretch, gave even response the final eighth in the four path. SANDRINGHAM HOTTIE bumped at the break raced evenly throughout holding position in the three path. TENDER ECHOS pressured the pace racing three deep through the turn, ceded to VERSAILLES SONG in upper stretch fading weary along the inside. DARK ENCHANTRESS bobbling at the break was rushed up pressing between horses through the turn, had nothing left upper stretch folding rapidly along the rail. GRAND NAJMAH veered out bumping at the break, stayed back throughout finishing at mid track. SEEKING BRANDY was always outrun. FLYINTHESKY struggled throughout. An objection from the rider of BATTLE OF T GIANTS against the rider of DITCH THE ACT for interference entering the stretch was disallowed by the stewards.
