Footnotes

EMMY WHO stalked to mid turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole, vied for the lead entering the stretch, drove clear mid stretch under strong left handed stick, held safe late being kept to task. PEGGE'S TREASURES settled in mid pack, launched rally coming four wide top of the lane, loomed off the winner at the eighth pole, needed more late and settled for second place. LENI'S JOY stalked from the start, saved ground around the turn, angled out turning for home, bid between foes mid stretch, was outfinished late holding on to third place. LITTLE HONOR lacked speed saving ground racing towards the rear, gained momentum upper stretch, angled out mid stretch brushing ALISSA WHO causing that rider to steady briefly, continued on finishing with interest. ALISSA WHO trailed down the backstretch, rallied five wide upper stretch, had to briefly steady in mid stretch when brushed by an angling LITTLE HONOR, improved placing besting rest. ROCIO STORM lacked speed running towards the rear, slightly improved placing in the lane traveling mid track but never menaced. PEPTO PANTSER showed good early foot setting the pace to the quarter pole, had little left inside the eighth pole faltering to the wire. TEXAS FLEETING broke alertly but was out sprinted by PEPTO PANSTER for the lead, stalked that rival to the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch, used up. TOUGH SOUP varied little racing in the second flight, weakened from upper stretch. SILERS SWEETHEART was a step slow from the gate, rushed up along the rail giving chase, stopped leaving the quarter pole.
