BULLCAT alert to the early lead moved away from rivals on the turn, opened up to full command in upper stretch, rider looked back finishing under wraps. TIPPING hustled close up to the turn, dropped off there continuing to save ground into the stretch, responded late along the inside to come on for place. SAILOR'S DREAM outrun early raced evenly through the turn coming four wide to upper stretch, gave mild response late to best others. SALTY N SASSY sent hard pursuing BULLCAT close up through the turn, proved no match dropping off the winner in upper stretch would weaken late ceding minor awards. DEMUS a step slow early played no factor. VICTORIA'S IMAGE hustled at mid pack retreating through the turn. ALPINE SINGER was always outrun. JAYHAWK JANET had good early speed managing to stay with BULLCAT through the turn, was worn out in upper stretch giving way.
