FAIR DINKUM stalked close up pressing to challenge on the far turn, dueling abreast GRAY WAGON in upper stretch bore down on rival drawing out late. GRAY WAGON broke alertly setting the pace on modest splits through the backside, collared by FAIR DINKUM on the far turn would duel from the rail down the stretch ceding the issue late. HOT TRIPPI tracked the pace along the inside chasing through the far turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch dropped off the leaders finishing evenly. PURELY BOY laid close up for three quarters of a mile, wavered in upper stretch fading in the four path. FINAL CURTAIN hustled up early weakened nearing the half giving way on the far turn. JO'S BLUE EYES dropping back early was always outrun.
