COACH DOUG came away alertly, pressed the pace through the turn then shook clear in upper stretch holding firm late. RAYWICK slow early was angled to mid track in upper stretch, came on late for place. MEISTERWERK slow early gave a mild rally to upper stretch, extended late would hang. DRILLER MAN was hustled out, chased through the turn then weakened the last eighth. TWINDIAN broke sharply, pressed hard through the turn, wore down in upper stretch. YOYO JABO played no factor. BLUE RODEO flashed early speed then gave way on the turn. PALAPPEAL dropped back on the turn. CAPTAIN KYLE was always outrun.
