MOON KID broke alertly pressuring the pace holding DIZENER at bay through the turn, shook off rival in upper stretch then drifted in despite left hand urging widening to wire. DIZENER was hustled out engaging MOON KID on pace, unable to draw even on the turn would cede to rival in upper stretch angling to the four path securing place. WILD GOOSE CREEK pressed early then chased through the turn, dropped off the leaders in upper stretch finishing evenly from mid track. KYLE'S TREASURY slow early improved position in the three path while never threatening. POP GOES THE TIGER broke sharply pressing then chasing four wide on the turn, would wear out at mid track in upper stretch. BLACK DIAMOND DAN played no factor. SHAKNDUZDABODYGOOD chased early then gave way abruptly on the turn, was vanned off after the race. SAY AGAIN was always outrun. MR. RAGS struggled throughout.
