INDIAN ANNABELLE broke sharply clearing the field maintaining a solid lead into upper stretch, dug in with an eye to IMA GIVEN who was looming on the outside finding more to hold sway. IMA GIVEN sat off INDIAN ANNABELLE from the gate to upper stretch, looming abreast rival the final eighth could make no headway. SUBBOO swung out early lost ground throughout coming seven wide in upper stretch gaining mild position there. ELIZA'S GREY tracked evenly through the turn, would drift while weakening at mid track down the stretch. ISABEL'S APPROVAL raced evenly never reaching contention. WHAT A MISTAKE hopped at the break laboring after. NONIGHTY was always a step slow. IT'S ON lost ground showing little. PERFECT MATCH struggled throughout.
