Footnotes

BROKE BY NOON well rated gave a prompted four wide move out of the far turn, came in brushing WOODMAN'S CHARM near the eighth pole then lugged in crowding rival a sixteenth out before going clear late. WOODMAN'S CHARM unhurried early gave a prompted middle move advancing through the far turn putting a head in front to upper stretch, was brushed by a drifting BROKE BY NOON near the eighth pole then crowded a bit later ceding to rival. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN tracked evenly through the backside then dropped off on the far turn, circled to mid track in upper stretch regrouped to vie willingly the final eighth. CAME TO SCORE sent clear set a soft early pace through the backside, collared on the far turn would cede near the rail in upper stretch weakening late. INCLUDE THE BLING rated off the pace was swung six wide in upper stretch, within striking distance lacked late punch. POWER OF TITUS stalked then pressured CAME TO SCORE on pace dueling through the far turn, extended to upper stretch would wear down late. YEMEN had little response. An objection from the rider of WOODMAN'S CHARM against the rider of BROKE BY NOON for interference through the stretch was disallowed by the stewards.
