TOO MANY CHOICES hustled to set a pressured pace along the rail, dueled on the turn in a four way battle, edged away mid stretch under a drive. IT'S MY SECRET sent hard from gate, pressed and vied while 4 wide on the turn, lost ground into the stretch, was all out in the drive and got up late for the place position in a game try. BOLD LINE slow early, saved ground, bid into lane, angled 5 wide mid stretch, closed gap late, willingly. GUMBY GIRL hustled and pressed for the lead while 3 wide and between rivals, tired in deep stretch. SHE'S THE TICKET sent hard to duel while between foes, vied to near the 1/4 pole, weakened from there. REASON FOR JUSTICE went evenly racing mid track throughout, asked upper stretch, offered little. FALSIFY went in mid pack along the rail, roused mid turn, showed little and weakened in the stretch run.
