FLY NOW broke sharply rushing off on brisk splits through the turn, leg weary inside the sixteenth pole had enough of a cushion to hold safe. ROSTER MAN tracked evenly through the turn, responded in drive getting to a tiring FLY NOW before running out of ground. GRADY O slow early found stride leaving the turn, vied willingly to wire. BOBBIE'S DEVIL chased a loose FLY NOW through the turn, wore down under a drive. CURTAIN BLUFF was always a step slow finishing at mid track. ZEPHYR CHARLIE dropped well back early. UNCLE TOODIE hustled along through the turn, wilted into upper stretch.
