**Footnotes**

EASTERMAN well rated gave a well timed move out of the far turn hooking rivals four deep in upper stretch then drew off under urging. CLASSIC RUCKIS sent to the top was used on pace holding LOOKINGFORAJACKPOT at bay through the far turn, joined by a trio in upper stretch extended between late saving place. LORD ELDON unhurried early gained through the far turn looming three wide into upper stretch, gave all the final eighth to no avail. EPPING saved ground responding on the far turn bidding from the rail in upper stretch, battling outside pressure would hang late. LOOKINGFORAJACKPOT was hustled out prompting CLASSIC RUCKIS down the backside, chased through the far turn then gradually wore down the final eighth. DEE FOR THREE was always a step slow. LEGENDARY MONARCH raced evenly for half a mile then flattened out on the far turn. TRADE SIGNAL unruly at the break was steadied back hard laboring after. DEEP SILENCE dropped back early laboring throughout.
