KOKOMO GYPSY tracked evenly through the turn, bid from three path down the lane, edged up late. R H CENTENARIO broke sharply, set the pace saving ground to upper stretch, dug in from the two path ceding late. DIXIE RUCKUS moved evenly through the turn, bid four wide upper stretch, hung late. HUTTER was bumped and squeezed at the break, raced wide proving no menace. MIRROR BALL veered out at the break, chased through the turn then wore down. GALLOWAY PAIGE in tight at the break was hurried in pursuit through the turn, folded in upper stretch. ILLUSTRATION off slowly raced six wide to upper stretch, proved no factor. MINERS MO was never involved. SAGUARO FLATS was always outrun. IRISH PASSION folded up on the turn.
