Footnotes

BIG BABY raced evenly off the pace through the turn, emerging in the three path upper stretch angled to the two slot driving up late. LIONSON broke sharply hustling a clear lead through the turn, drifted in upper stretch then angled out toward mid track late being caught on the wire. THE RAG MAN raced evenly through the turn, emerged near mid track in upper stretch, threatening late lacked punch. SPEEDY GRAHAM hopped at the break, stayed back through the turn, mustered a mild response to modestly improve position mid stretch. SPECIALNESS raced second flight finishing evenly in the six path. FALSE HOPE was always a step slow. DON'S APOLLO herded at the break by LOGAN'S LAKE played no factor. GRANDSTOWN GROVE chased the pace through the turn then tired along the inside in upper stretch. LOGAN'S LAKE veered out herding DON'S APOLLO early, stayed back racing eight wide through the lane.
